1.01 Truth in Taxation Hearing and Public Hearing

Mrs. Strain stated that, in compliance with A.R.S. §15-1461.01, the Cochise County Community College District is notifying the property taxpayers of Cochise County Community College District's intention to raise its primary property taxes over the last year's level. The Cochise County Community College District is proposing an increase in primary property taxes of \$365,539.00 or 2.0%. For example, the proposed tax increase will cause Cochise County Community College District's primary property taxes on \$100,000.00 to increase from \$181.45 to \$185.08.

Dr. Rottweiler stated that this notice has been advertised, consistent with this statute, and the paper of record for the county was the Sierra Vista Herald. Courtesy copies of the notice were also sent to the Douglas Dispatch and the San Pedro Valley Sun News.

Mrs. Strain opened the floor for public comments. Hearing none, she moved to the next agenda item.

2. New Business

2.01 Approval of Increase in the Primary Property Tax (FY 2013-2014)

Mr. Nelson moved and Mr. DiPeso seconded a motion to approve, by roll call vote, an increase of 2.0% in the primary property tax levy for the Cochise County Community College District in fiscal year 2013-2014.
