RE: MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Dear Dr. Fick,

Thank you for becoming a transfer partner of Western Governors University (WGU). We share your goal of providing affordable and accessible degree programs to all of your graduates and staff. This agreement will cover all Cochise County Community College District (Cochise College) campuses under that assumption that your degree program requirements are uniform across all sites.

Under the terms of this agreement, WGU will:

1. Provide graduates of Cochise College a 5% discount on tuition for up to four terms;
2. Provide transfer tables for all related degree programs in education, business, information technology and nursing. These tables show the Cochise College credits that transfer to a WGU bachelor's degree program and the courses required at WGU to complete a bachelor's degree;
3. Consider graduates and staff of Cochise College as eligible to apply for scholarships offered by WGU. Scholarships can be found at: http://www.wgu.edu/tuition_financial_aid/scholarships; and
4. Participate in transfer events and other related activities hosted by Cochise College.

In return, we ask that Cochise College:

1. Maintain a link between the Cochise College web site and the WGU landing page for partner college graduates and staff;
2. Maintain current brochures describing WGU degree programs and services in your counseling/transfer offices. WGU will provide these materials at no charge; and
3. Include information about WGU programs and services in communications sent to impending graduates and prospective transfer students.

This MOU may be cancelled or modified with 30 days written notice by either party. Cancellation will not limit the benefits of this agreement for any Cochise College graduates or staff who are enrolled in good standing at WGU or in the enrollment process.
